Letter of the President

Salzburg, 26th September 2022

Dear members of the European Academy of Sciences and Arts,

at the Presidium meeting on 22 September and the Senate meeting on 23 September, the date for the 2023 General Assembly and Festive Plenary was set for Saturday morning, 15 April 2023. This is the weekend after Easter and it lends itself to an extended Easter holiday in Salzburg. On Friday 14 April there will already be workshops of our expert groups.

The white papers of the two expert groups on digitalisation/artificial intelligence and energy/environment are already well advanced and were already presented in workshops during the General Assembly/Festive Plenary at the beginning of July this year. The aim is to highlight the Academy's expertise in these topics and thus raise the Academy's profile. With corresponding proposals from the Academy, contact can then also be made with other scientific organisations in Europe. Against the background of the energy crisis, our Academy is taking up a topic of existential importance for this continent with energy technology, environmental goals and digitalisation.

Further on, at its last meeting, the Senate decided to set up an expert group in the field of humanities and cultural studies as well. In the global crises and conflicting goals, the humanities could play a key role of orientation. The Dean of Class I, Andreas Önnersfors, was commissioned to explore a profile-forming theme for the Academy with his class.

Our academy unites the sciences with the arts. This distinguishes us from many other academies worldwide. Especially in times of crisis and war, the arts have proven to be a central link between people because they not only appeal to the intellect, but also to our emotions, imagination and creativity. Since last year, the event series "Science meets Arts/Arts meets Science" has been extremely successful and is literally attracting worldwide audiences. After the summer break, it will be continued regularly in the winter semester 2022/2023, coordinated by the Dean of Class III (Arts) and the Dean of Class IV (Natural Sciences) (see Schedule/Events). By popular demand, the series will also be continued next year in the summer semester 2023. Under the coordination of the Dean of the Art Class, all classes interested in interdisciplinary topics on art and science will be involved. If you are interested in an exciting topic on art with your discipline during the summer term 2023, please contact Violeta Dinescu as Dean of the Class of Arts (violeta.dinescu@euro-acad.eu). A separate call will go out to the deans.

For further ongoing events and activities, I recommend all members to check the website. Finally, I ask for active support and participation of our activities. As was already called for at the General Assembly and Festive Plenary, we want to be a working Academy.
